PROJECT OUTLINE

This project's goal is to provide the Karl Huesner Memorial Hospital with a van for the morgue.

As the largest population center in the Country, Belize City remains with limited morgue resources. Currently, the various agencies involved in this area use open air pickups or private vehicles for the removal of human remains. A proper morgue van has never been acquired.

This is not only unsightly and disrespectful, but also not hygienic.

We propose to buy a new van locally which will provide ease of servicing and make the issue of shipping and importation, mute. One year of insurance is also included. We also propose to suggest to the hospital for them to charge a small usage fee to help with maintenance and upkeep.

This project has been needed for a long time but has always been far down the list of priorities for a cash strapped medical facility.

We hope that it is considered favorably.
