On July 3rd he was flown to Alabama. This week was the first time that he was out of bed and sitting up for 5 minutes. He still needs to have his last major graft. He has required 100% coverage of his skin. They regrow skin using the placenta or afterbirth. Last surgery will be on Tuesday. He is coming along well. He will have to have more surgeries. Duane Flowers wife is also with him. It is known that during healing, loving care and compassion contributes to his recovery. The care-providers are all very loving and compassionate. When he started to cry, first nurse Rebecca also started and then nurse Maria came into room and she started crying as well. This is special level of care. Cisco shared his own experiences saying that when you have no skin they use the skin of a cadaver or use pig skin to cover the body. Says pictures of foot looked like chicharon. They are making amazing progress with new methods. Skin is largest organ - without it the body is susceptible to infections and losing fluids. Can go into septic shock, so skins are used as temporary covers. Toughest skin on body is on head, elbows and knees. Grown skin is the thickness of toilet paper. It is moistened, and then placed on the most delicate areas.
